During 25th - 28th November 2014 the first meeting between the partners involved in the project of the strategic partnership of Erasmus+ Programme "Hands-on Development Strategies in the Content-Centered Context for Young and Adult Learners with Basic Skills in Literacy and Poor Numeracy" took place in Budapest.

The team of the Teachers' Training Center led by the director of the institution, Gabriela Nichifor, met the representatives of Országos Tranzitfoglalkoztatási Egyesület (OTE) - Debrecen/Hungary, Edirne Endüstri ve Teknik Lisesi meslek - Edirne/Turkey, Centro Integrado Medina del Campo of Professional Formación - Medina del Campo/Spain and Klaipedos Valstybine kolegija - Klaipeda/Lithuania.

The aim of the project is to combat and prevent the early school leaving and the planned activities are intended to improve the school results of the students/young people with a low level of fundamental acquisitions development.

The project will result in the development and delivery of a training program for teachers working with students/young people with learning difficulties and/or at risk of school failure and dropout as well as the realisation of a methodological guide (new methods and tools for teachers) to be applied in the schools of the partner countries.

The Teachers' Training Center Tulcea will develop and accredit the training program, which will then be delivered to a target group of 10 teachers from Romania and 20 teachers from European countries.
